

### 1538 to 1837



#### **Current Records**

- Civil registration 1837
  - Birth
  - Marriage
  - Death
- > Census records
- Enlistment First and Second World War
- Marriage age changes




#### Common Mistakes

- Baptism not Birth
- Events to young
- Hints and tips added without checking
- Life too long
- Written Numbers
- > Education
- Census ages
- Quarters on civil registration records
- Graves
- > Events out of order

## Problems with Documents

- > Transcription errors
- Numbers in margins
- Faint / Smudged
- Damaged pages

- Use an age range around date
- Be aware of time period
- Calendars
- > Type of event
- > Look at timelines
- Original Records
- Handwriting
- > Other record sets

## Recap

- Don't fixated on a year
- Use a year range when searching
- Be aware ages can be recorded wrong
- > Always check original records were possible
- Check which calendar is in use
- > Bear in mind the period your researching
- Use multiple sites
- > Always use multiple record types
- Check death age on GRO
