ACCIDENTAL DEATH.

INQUEST ON LLANRHYSTYD MAN.

The adjourned inquest on Richard Isaac (22), Goitre, Llanrhystyd, who died at Aberystwyth Infirmary on the night of Tuesday week, from injuries received through a horse bolting, was conducted at Aberystwyth Police Station on Friday by Mr. T. Eyton Morgan, Aberystwyth.

George Evans (13), Glanrafon, Ponterwyd, said he met deceased returning with a horse and cart from the Co-operative Stores, Blaenavon. Witness got into the cart and as they passed the red mail motor van, which was stationery the horse took fright and started running away. There was plenty of room to pass and the engine of the mail motor van was not running. Witness did not hear any noise. Deceased caught hold of the reins and fell out; but witness did not see him fall as he was looking the other way. Witness jumped out of the cart as the horse was running; but was not hurt. The horse was stopped by David Phillips, Tynynydd.

The Coroner: When you were passing the mail van was deceased looking in front or speaking to you?—Witness: He was looking in front.

Mrs. Anne Jones, Garnwyalen, Bethania, said when she first saw the horse it was walking; but when it saw the red motor van it started galloping. She saw deceased jump out of the cart. He was dragged along the ground and witness could see that the cart had been over him.

The Coroner returned a verdict of "Accidental Death" caused by internal hemorrhage and shock caused by jumping out of the cart while the horse bolted.

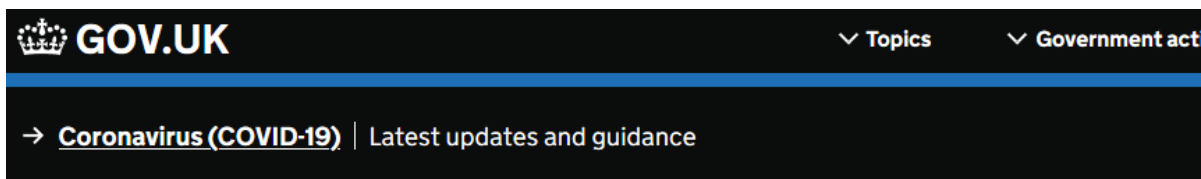

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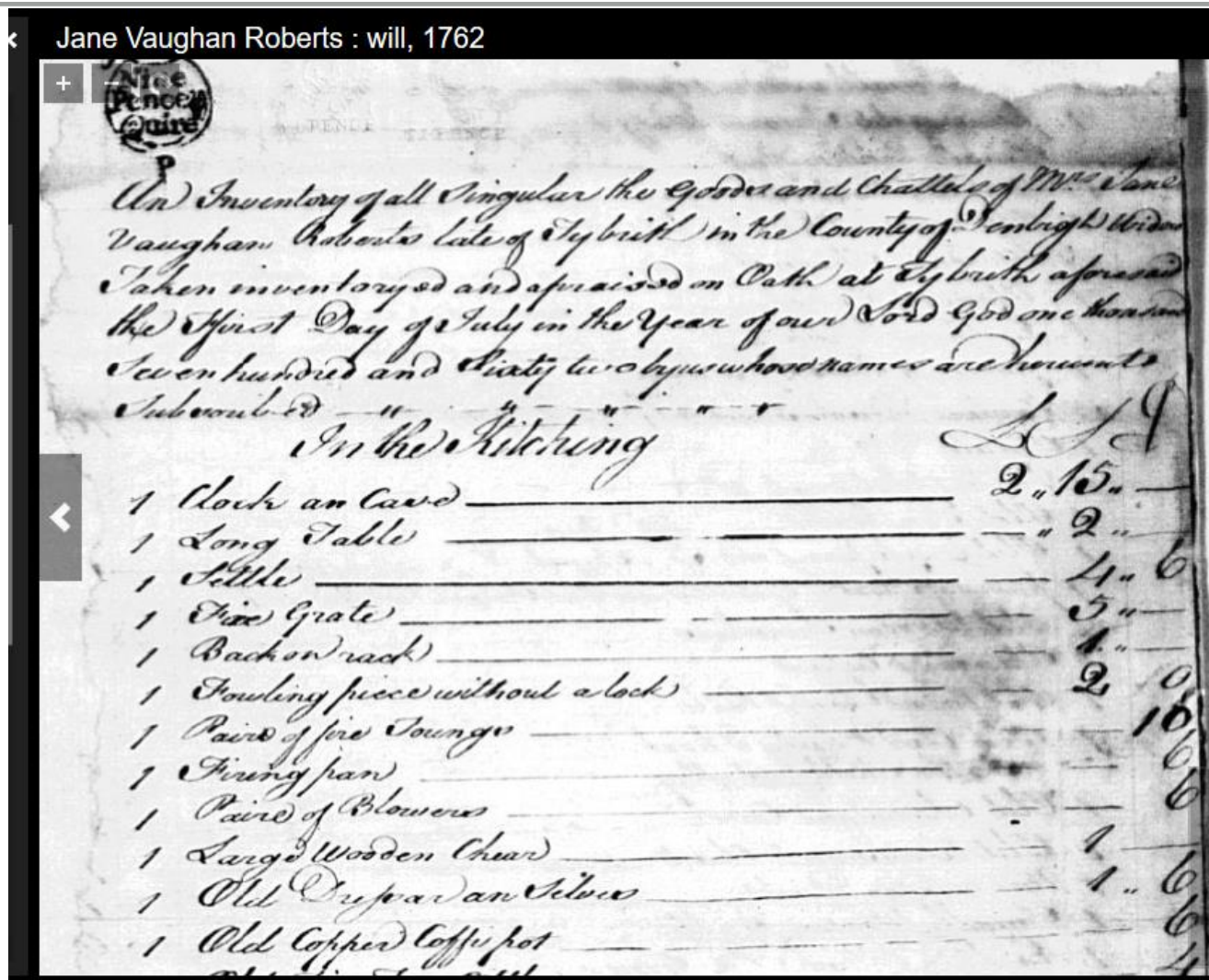

Post-1858 Probate Records



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Find a probate record, also known as a 'grant of representation', for someone who died after 1857.

Probate gives someone the legal right to deal with a deceased person's property, money and possessions (their 'estate').

A new probate record will be online approximately 14 days after probate has been issued.

There's a different process in Scotland and Northern Ireland.

You can use this service to:

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- check the type of probate issued
- order a copy of a probate record (including a will, if there is one)
