- New data is indexed on a voluntary basis.
- The data has not been checked and contain many errors.
- The information found in the database should always be checked against the original church records.

- Own archival material digitisation project.
- Less public material and it is older.
 - Communion and other church records.
- Newer material for members of the association.
 - e.g. communion records, court records, county records and military rolls.
 - Colour photographs of original documents.

- Database of indexed church records of the ceded Karelian region.
- The source material of the Karelian database includes church records of the ceded region for the period 1700-1950.
 - Lutheran parish records
 - Orthodox church records
