
ACCESSING HELPER RESOURCES

- Go to FamilySearch.org
- Sign in
- Click on the ? icon located in the upper right
- From the dropdown menu, click on Helper Resources

Resource Links

Helper Resources provides quick links to frequently accessed content, including:

- Recent Article for Latter-day Saints connects to the FamilySearch blog and highlights communications specific to temple and family history and to those who hold temple and family history callings and responsibilities.
- What's New at FamilySearch also point to the FamilySearch blog, though is for every FamilySearch user and highlights newly released records, projects, and products.



- FamilySearch Community connects you with others participating in family history across
 the globe. It is a great place to ask questions and share expertise.
- Easy Invitations identifies temple opportunities, record hints and discovery experiences for the members of your ward or branch. Some members do not have an email associated with their FamilySearch account and may not have seen the personalized Tree experience emails or notifications. They made need your encouragement to sign into FamilySearch. You simply copy the link next to their name and send it via text, email, WhatsApp, or another method. Once they click on the link, they will see the personalized opportunities in their Tree. When you share an invitation, it is also a great opportunity to extend an offer to help them learn more about their family's story. As a helper, you will not see the another

person's information shared in the link. To see their Tree information, you need to use the Planner.


Planner

On the right side of Helper Resources is access to the Planner. The Planner consists of two sections:

- 1. My Planner
- 2. People You Are Helping

My Planner

This highlights temple, record hints, and discovery experiences personalized to each family Tree. This feature is open to everyone and is a great place to start when introducing someone to their Family Tree.



In addition, My Planner provides access to Notes and Plans, features enabling everyone to create documentation to help them remember key points and to organize their research.

People You Are Helping

This feature is for members of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints who provide personalized family history experiences for others – whether or not the person being helped is a member of the Church.

Training Materials are available to help you succeed in using the Planner features to help others such as how to use the Planner to view another person's tree, how to send and invitation, and how to delete someone from your Planner list.

To access these resources, while on the Helper Resources page, click on the ? icon in the upper right and look under Suggested Topics.
