

Okinawa Background

Okinawa Geography

Ryūkyū Islands (琉球諸島) – Broad definition – stretching from Kyūshū (九州) in north to Taiwan (台湾) in south

- Ōsumi Islands (大隅諸島)
- <u>■ Tokara Islands (吐噶喇列島)</u>
- ◆ Amami Islands (奄美群島)
- Okinawa Islands (沖縄諸島)
- Miyako Islands (宮古列島)
- Yaeyama Islands (八重山列島)
- Daitō Islands (大東諸島)
- Senkaku Islands (尖閣諸島)

Okinawa History

- Unified Ryūkyū Kingdom 1429
- Satsuma Invasion 1609
 - Independent country
 - Tributary to China
 - Vassal to Japan
 - Considerable trade during closure of Japan to outside
- Okinawa Prefecture established 1879 (other prefectures in 1872)
 - Annexation
 - Policy of elimination of Ryūkyūan culture, language, religion


Okinawa History

- Battle of Okinawa April 1 to June 22, 1945
 - 1/3 of civilian population killed (300,000 people)
 - U.S. Military Occupation 1945 to 1950
 - U.S. Civil Occupation 1950 to 1972
- U.S. Military Presence
 - 75% of U.S. military forces in Japan are located in Okinawa
 - 18% of the main island of Okinawa under U.S. military control

Ryukyuan Languages

Lumped in Japonic language family, but Japanese and Ryukyuan languages are not mutually intelligible. Ryukyuan languages also not mutually intelligible with each other.

- Amami (奄美)
- Kunigami (国頭)
- Okinawa (沖縄)
- Miyako (宮古)
- Yaeyama (八重山)
- Yonaguni (与那国)

Okinawan Cultural/Historical Factors Affecting Family History

- Favoring
 - Ryukyuan religion indigenous animism and ancestor worship
 - Influence of Chinese recordkeeping some Okinawa family records can trace back to BCE China
- Opposing
 - Destruction of records in World War II
 - Some reconstruction of destroyed records (koseki, etc.) in 1950s, but many were not

Okinawan Migration Record Database

Joint effort

- Okinawa Prefectural Library (Naha, Okinawa, Japan)
- Okinawan Genealogical Society of Hawaii (Mililani, Hawaii)
- Center for Okinawa Migration Studies (Nishihara, Okinawa, Japan)

Initiated in 2000 by Okinawa Genealogical Society of Hawaii – gradual addition and translation of records. Some additional work to be done.

Based on migration records from the Diplomatic Archives of the Japanese Ministry of Foreign Affairs.

Why is the Okinawan Migration Record Database a "Game Changer"?

- Based upon Japanese emigration records instead of non-Japanese immigration records
- Open internet access instead of limited archive access
- Indexed data instead of microfilm images
- Emigration to multiple countries
- Search capabilities in English, Japanese, Portuguese, and Spanish
- Provides 本籍地 (honsekichi "permanent residence") key information for requesting koseki documents
- Sets an important precedent for the Japanese Ministry of Foreign Affairs and other prefectures



Okinawan Migration Record Database 1900-1937

This database was developed in a joint collaboration with the Okinawa Prefectural Library (OPL) in Naha, Okinawa Genealogical Society of Hawaii (OGSH), and Center for Okinawa Migration Studies (COMS) to enable Okinawan people around the world to discover their roots and promote, preserve and perpetuate the Okinawan culture.

You can search the 50,000 emigration records from 1900 to 1937 of Okinawans who ventured from Okinawa to all over the world.

The travel record data is based on the books "Okinawa Prefectural Historical Materials: Modern 5 (Immigratino List I), which is an excerpt from the "Overseas Passport Subscript" held by Diplomatic Archives of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Japan.

OPL provides an additional research by using other resources.





In the [Travel Purpose] field above, you may see "Yobiyose" which means "Summoning". This means a person already in the country has petitioned the immigration authorities to allow a spouse, family member, relative or even a friend to join him/her. "Household Head" is the patrirach (male) of a group of families.

The Passport Number is not unique. An individual could be issued a different number on a repeat trip. Also an entire family can travel under one passport number so it may appear that passport numbers are duplicated
