### **Dimension 1: Preparation**

- → Ask a relative (Parents, Aunts, Uncles, Grandparents, Cousins)
- → Plan your research (What do you need to know?)

- → Better sources?
- → Write your ancestor's story
- → Share what you have found
- → Cemetery Visit
- → Time Capsule
